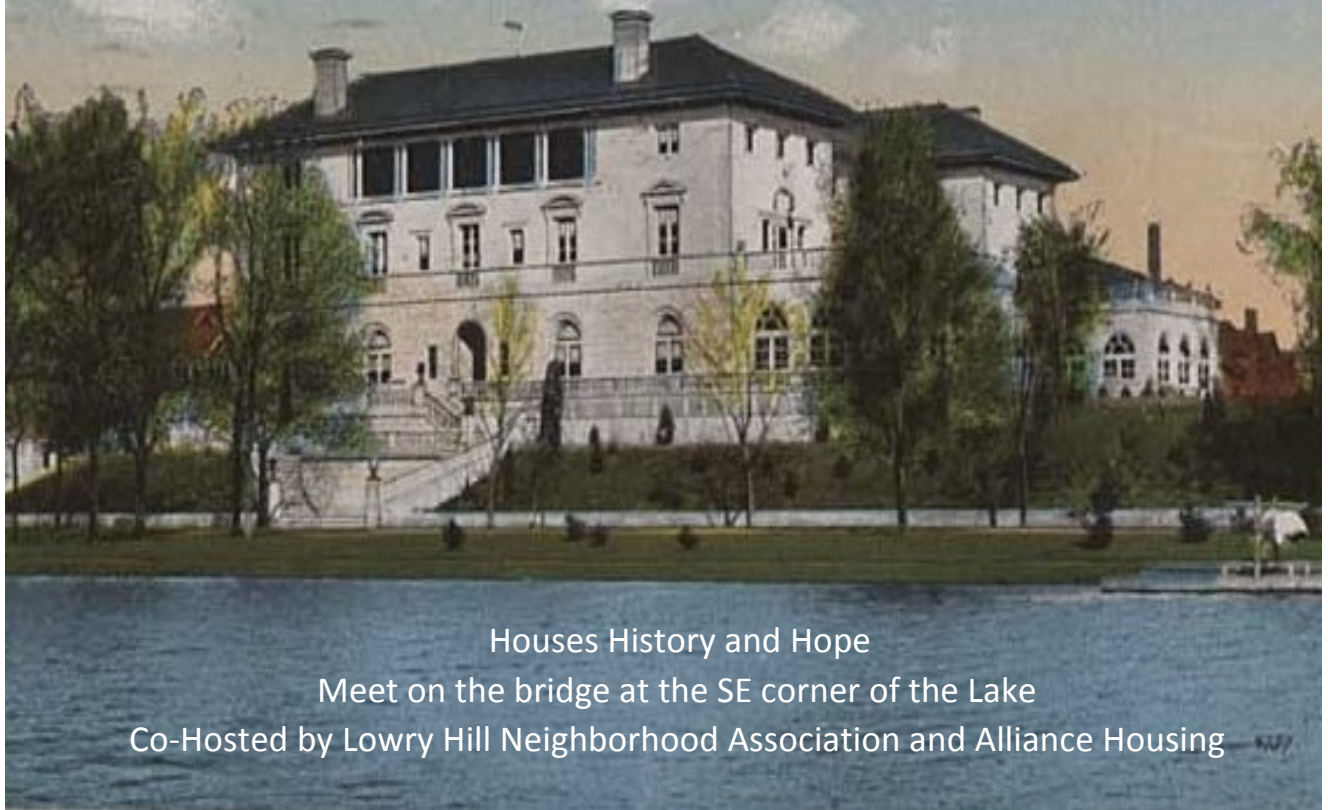


## An Historical Walking Tour Around Lake of the Isles
