PERIS Hill Update

Carla Godwin was not in attendance, but Jennifer Breitinger provided an update about Carla's continued work on submitting the \$15,000 NRP grant proposal and plans to seek another \$25,000 from the Partnership Engagement Grant.

Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes

William Goodnow presented the meeting minutes from the February 6, 2024 and March 5 meetings, which were distributed to the board members by email in advance of the meeting. After discussion, both sets of meeting minutes were approved.

Minneapolis City Council Update

Ward 7 Council Member Katie Cashman was not in attendance.

Minneapolis Police Department Update

Inspector Christie Nelson was not in attendance.

Crime & Safety Update

Sue Westerman provided March crime statistics by email in advance of the meeting, and William Goodnow reviewed those materials with the board and responded questions by the board about the same.

Treasurer's Report

The treasurer's report was postponed until the May 2024 board meeting.

Zoning

Fran Davis provided a zoning update, highlighting that she is monitoring the city permitting progress for the redevelopment project that was presented by the Baylor family at the March 2024 board meeting, and also provided an overview of the board's role in the city permitting process.

Events Update

William Goodnow and Sarah Grundhoefer provided an update on recent and upcoming safety walks, including a discussion about the March 23 walk and the upcoming April 20 Earth Day clean-up walk that will begin at 10am.

Communications Update

Communications Chair Sarah Grundhoefer provided an update on communications, including an overview of improvements to the board's social media and blast email practices and the need to promote upcoming board openings to the community. Sarah also noted that she had sent the board members an email with updates from Cuyler about recent Ward 7 and Farmers Market meetings, and noted that Cuyler continues to work on modernizing the website and doing market research with Google analytics.

Grant Programs

Will Stencil provided an update on the façade grant, including plans to liaison with local businesses, and answered questions about the same.

Annual Meeting

William Goodnow provided an update on planning for the Tuesday, June 4 annual meeting to be held at First Unitarian. The board discussed a variety of related topics, including (i) relevant topics to recommend that the confirmed speakers' include prepared remarks (Council Member Cashman and Inspector Nelson), (ii) an additional speaker who could address the Hennepin Avenue reconstruction, (iii) the availability of question cards for annual meeting attendees to complete, (iv) the use of a mailer to advertise the annual meeting and (v) food, beverages and door prizes to be provided at the meeting. After discussion, the board approved a \$1,250 budget for food, beverages and door prizes at the annual meeting.

Governance

Fran Davis provided an update on governance matters, including a discussion about board applications received to date, upcoming term expirations for herself, Chas Scheiderer and Jennifer Breitinger, other board vacancies, leadership planning/transition to be discussed at the June 2024 board meeting and the need for new board member training.
